## Confirmation Requirements

To complete the Confirmation program, students are expected to:

- Attend Monthly Confirmation Classes
- **Serve Monthly in BodyWorks:** BodyWorks includes a bunch of ways to serve on a Sunday morning- greeting, coffee hour, reading scripture, helping in the nursery, and more. You will be assigned dates/roles.
- Submit Monthly Sermon Notes (forms will be provided)
- Conduct at Least Two Connection Interviews: Interview two church members from different generations
- Attend a New Friends & Members Lunch: New member lunches are 9/21 and 1/18
